Here's a vivid reminder of what can happen when traveling too fast on slippery roadways. This semi truck was passing another vehicle and rear-ended a Marquette County snowplow. The resulting crash damaged several vehicles and caused significant delays for many others.

With more winter still to come tonight, drivers are reminded that state law requires vehicles to stay at least 200 feet behind a working snowplow. If you decide to pass a plow, be very cautious.
