

What you can do depends on the reason for your cancellation.

- You always have the option of providing a new/updated Medical Examination Report
 □ MV3644 or the Certificate of Vision Examination by Competent Authority □ MV3030V if
 your condition improves. An improvement may help you meet medical standards and re establish your ability to drive safely. If you send the DMV a new report, we will review it and
 send you a letter with the results.
- You may appeal the decision to cancel by requesting a review by the Medical Review Board.

Information about this process is mailed with every cancellation/denial notice.

• Drivers whose license is canceled for failing an exam must demonstrate an ability to pass the exam before further licensing.
