

If you receive notice of a safety responsibility suspension, you may request a hearing. The review is limited to whether a reasonable possibility of a judgment exists against you for:

- Involvement in the crash
- Liability for the crash
- Amount of bond claimed as a result of the crash

Drivers and witnesses are placed under oath and testify on the record. You may be represented by an attorney. You may provide evidence, including:

- Witnesses
- Sworn affidavits
- Photographs
