

Issued to out-of-state motor carriers traveling intrastate or interstate who do not have proper registration or fuel tax credentials in Wisconsin as set forth in Sec. [341.41\(7\)](#), and [341.45](#) Stats. This permit is also issued for carriers who do not have proper registration or fuel tax credentials in the jurisdictions that belong to the international trip permit compact.

The trip permit for Wisconsin is valid for 72 hours from the time and date on the permit. There may be different dates and times for each jurisdiction listed on the permit. Valid for one round trip only.

Most applicants buy both registration and fuel, but the temporary registration and the in-lieu-of fuel tax portions may be purchased separately. The fee for each part is \$15, for a total of \$30 if both are purchased.

Payment may be made with a valid credit or debit card (Visa, MasterCard, Discover or American Express) or ACH (Automated Clearing House) payment from your checking or savings account. Your credit or debit card will be charged a [convenience fee](#) for this service. There is no convenience fee charged for ACH payment.

Permit Conditions

- This credential authorizes operation into and within Wisconsin for one round trip within 72 hours of the effective date appearing on the permit.
- This permit is for the vehicle listed and the permit must be carried in the vehicle.
- If the vehicle is leased, a copy of the lease must be carried in the vehicle.
- If the vehicle is operated for-hire, contact each jurisdiction for appropriate credentials.
- A proper certificate of insurance must be on file with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation, in accordance with the Wisconsin insurance requirements before a vehicle can be operated by rental-charter or for-hire carrier on Wisconsin highways with this permit. Permittee must comply with authority, leasing marking and all other motor transportation requirements.

Permit not valid if the carrier or vehicle is stopped and is found to be operating in violation of an FMCSA issued out-of-service order.
