

As of **June 17, 2019**, we are working on applications we received on:

- May 28, 2019 for mailed in auto and light truck titles¹ and/or non-personalized license plates
- May 28, 2019 for mailed in heavy truck titles¹
- June 14, 2019 for eMV Public applications
- June 9, 2019 for license plate renewals²
- May 28, 2019 for personalized and most special interest license plates²
- June 10, 2019 for record requests
- June 3, 2019 for (new) bonded title applications

Your check is cashed immediately after we receive your application and we place it into the queue for processing. All applications are processed in the order in which they are received. Applications that are missing proper signatures, information or required documentation will take longer to

process.

DMV online services available:

- License plate search find out when your plate expires; get the RRN number to renew your plates online; check to see if an emissions test is required for the vehicle; find out if your plate is suspended or valid.
- eMV Public fastest, most convenient way to title and register (receive or transfer plates) for your new vehicle in Wisconsin.
- Where's my title? know if your title has been processed recently and when to expect it in the mail.

Additional information:

- 1. As of July 30, 2012, state law requires the Department to deliver all titles to the lien holder (lender). Check Lien search to see if there is a lien on your vehicle. If the title was sent to the lien holder, the vehicle owner will receive a Confirmation of Ownership document that provides the same information as a title, but cannot be used to transfer ownership or record another lien.
- 2. Please allow 10 days from the processing date to receive your license plates, stickers and certificate of registration. Please allow an additional four weeks from the issuance of the certificate of registration for manufacturing and mailing of personalized and some special plates.
