

Any Wisconsin resident may apply for In God We Trust license plates. Donations from these plates benefit Wisconsin Veteran Home member care.

Vehicles that qualify

automobiles

- motor homes (annual registration only)
- motor trucks
 - 4,500, 6,000 or 8,000 pounds gross weight including dual purpose farm and dual purpose motor home
 - 12,000 pounds gross weight farm truck

Things you should know:

When you request In God We Trust license plates, you pay:

- \$25 annual donation that WisDOT transfers to the Wisconsin Department of Veterans Affairs (WDVA) Wisconsin Veteran Home member care. The donation may be deductible if you itemize your income tax returns.
- \$15 issuance fee or an annual \$15 personalized plate fee, if requested. DOT transfers issuance fees to WDVA Veterans Trust Fund.
- The regular registration fee for your vehicle if your current plates expire within three months or you have no plates

At each plate renewal, you will pay the \$25 donation and the regular registration fee for non-personalized In God We Trust plates.

How to apply

Local DMV customer service centers do not have In God We Trust license plates for immediate issue, but can process applications; the plates will be mailed. Temporary plates will be issued, if needed.

To apply by mail, please send the following items:

- 1. If the vehicle you want to register with In God We Trust plates is already titled/registered in your name, send:

 - \$25 In God We Trust donation
 - \$15 issuance fee or \$15 personalized plate fee
 - The annual registration fee if your current plates expire within the next three months or you have no plates
- 2. If the vehicle is **not** titled/registered in your name, send:
 - A completed Wisconsin Title & License Plates Application □ MV1, or MV11 for dealer sales, including all other fees due
 - A completed In God We Trust License Plate Information and Application

 MV2971
 - The Certificate of Title assigned to you by the seller
 - \$25 In God We Trust donation
 - \$15 issuance fee or \$15 personalized plate fee
 - The annual registration fee if you do not have plates or your current plates expire within the next three months
- 3. Make the check or money order made payable to: **Registration Fee Trust**.

Personalized license plates

Personalizing your In God We Trust license plates is optional. A \$15 personalized plate fee is **required each year** in addition to the \$25 donation and regular annual registration fee. On the In God We Trust License Plate Information and Application MV2971, check which option you would like us to follow if your request is not available. Please allow an additional 4-6 weeks for delivery.

Visit Personalized plate search to find out if your choice for a personalized license plate is available. WisDOT may refuse to issue, or may recall after issuance, a request that may be offensive to good taste or decency, misleading or conflicts with any other license plate.
