

If you need to make any changes to your occupational license, you will need to reapply for the license. You must appear at a DMV customer service center (excluding Renewal Only offices) with:

- Completed Driver License Application ☐ MV3001
- Completed Application for Occupational License ☐ MV3027
- Proof of Identity (your current occupational license or Social Security Card)
- Occupational license issuance fee

If your current occupational license was issued after petitioning the circuit court in your county of residence, the court must approve any changes.


