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Change your residence address online

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This online system will allow you to change your Wisconsin residence and/or mailing address for your Wisconsin driver license/ID and vehicle license plates/registration. If you would like a driver license or identification card that shows your new address, you will need to apply for a duplicate driver license or identification card online or visit a [DMV customer service center](#) and pay the required fee.

You will not be able to use this online system if:

- You hold a Commercial Driver License (CDL) or a Commercial Learner Permit (CLP) that has not expired. Customers who hold a valid CDL or CLP are required to obtain a new driver license with their current address on it. You may be eligible to [apply for a duplicate online](#). The online duplicate system will allow you to change your address and request a new license

in one step. If you are not eligible to apply online, please visit a [DMV customer service center](#). You will need to show your Social Security card, Federal Medical card (if applicable) and pay the fee for a duplicate.

To use this online system, you must enter the following:

- Your Wisconsin driver license number or Wisconsin identification card number
- The last four digits of your social security number, and
- Your date of birth

If you do not wish to enter this information online, download Address Change Notice [MV3058](#). Complete and mail to the address listed on the form.

This service may not be available on Sundays from 6 a.m.–9 a.m. due to regular system maintenance.
