The Department of Natural Resources announces that it will hold a public hearing on a permanent rule to revise ch. NR 20, relating to Minocqua Chain walleye harvest regulation, at the time and place shown below.

Hearing Information

Rule Information:

This emergency rule will extend the existing walleye harvest regulation on the Minocqua Chain of Lakes (consisting of Kawaguesaga, Minocqua, Mid, Little Tomahawk and Tomahawk) from April to May 2021. The current regulation is slated to sunset in April 2020. Extending this rule by one additional year will allow walleye stocked into these waters to continue to replenish populations on the Minocqua Chain. The department anticipates that by 2021, adult walleye numbers will reach established goals and natural reproduction will occur.

This rule extends the zero bag limit and defines the size limit as “none” until May 2021.
