**NOTICE OF SUBMISSION OF PROPOSED RULES TO  
THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STAFF**

NOTICE IS GIVEN, pursuant to s. 227.14 (4m), Stats., that on this date, the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin submitted a proposed rule to the Legislative Council Staff (Rules Clearinghouse) for review. The proposed rule, Commission docket 1-AC-252, deals with allowing an electric provider, or customer or member of an electric provider, to create a renewable resource credit for heat that is a byproduct of a manufacturing process and is used to provide thermal energy for another purpose.

The Statement of Scope for this rule, SS 012-19, was approved by the Governor on December 20, 2018, published in *Wisconsin Administrative Register* No. 757A3 on January 14, 2019, and approved by the Commission on April 2, 2020.

A public hearing will be held on Monday, January 25, 2021, at 1:00 p.m. The hearing does not have a physical location and will be held virtually.
