NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND COMMENT PERIOD

The Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection announces that it will hold a public hearing on Emergency Rule EmR2316 and Emergency Rule EmR2317 relating to providing crop insurance rebates for cover crops and creating a commercial nitrogen optimization pilot program, at the time and place shown below.

EmR2316 implements the crop insurance premium rebates for planting cover crop program created under s. 92.14 (17) Stats. The Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection is authorized to provide rebates in the amount of \$5 for each acre of a cover crop planted for crop insurance premiums paid on those acres.

EmR2317 implements the commercial nitrogen optimization pilot project program created under s. 92.14 (16) Stats. The Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection is authorized to make grants for nitrogen optimization pilot projects conducted in collaboration with a University of Wisconsin System (UWS) institution.
