## CHAPTER 337.

AN ACT to amend 4.01 (Kenosha county) of the statutes, relating to assembly districts in Kenosha county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4.01 (Kenosha county) of the statutes is amended to read:

4.01 (Kenosha county) The \* \* \* third, fourth, \* \* \* fifth, sixth, seventh, thirteenth, fourteenth, fifteenth, sixteenth, seventeenth and eighteenth wards of the city of Kenosha shall constitute the first district.

The towns of Brighton, Bristol, Paris, Pleasant Prairie, Randall, Salem, Somers and Wheatland; the villages of Silver Lake and Twin Lakes; and the first, \* \* *second, eighth, ninth, tenth,* eleventh and twelfth wards of the city of Kenosha shall constitute the second district.

## CHAPTER 338.

AN ACT to create 320.08 of the statutes, relating to the apportionment of trustees' fees as between income and principal of the trust.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

320.08 of the statutes is created to read :

320.08 In the absence of any direction in an instrument creating a trust, unless the court having jurisdiction over the administration thereof shall otherwise direct, seventy-five per centum of the customary annual fees of the trustee shall be charged against the incomes, and twenty-five per centum thereof shall be charged against the corpus of the trust.
