## CHAPTER 50.

AN ACT to create 236.055 of the statutes, relating to requirements entitling plats to be recorded.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

236.055 of the statutes is created to read:

236.055 Delinquent Taxes and Assessments. In addition to other requirements entitling a final plat to be recorded there shall be filed with the register of deeds a certificate of the treasurer of the county stating that there are no delinquent taxes or delinquent special assessments on any of the lands included in the plat.

## CHAPTER 51.

AN ACT to amend 40.04 (13) of the statutes, relating to the salaries of school board members.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

40.04 (13) of the statutes is amended to read:

40.04 (13) To vote salaries to the members of the school board, but the salary to the treasurer and the director shall not exceed \$20 each and the salary to the clerk shall not exceed \$25, except that in districts with more than one common school the salary of each board member may be \$5 additional for each additional school, unless the district maintains a state graded or a high school. Limitations herein set forth shall not apply to school districts operating \* \* \* state graded schools, high schools with grades or high schools.
