16	${f 3.}$ Page 3, line 11: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with
17	page 4, line 5, and substitute:
18	"SECTION 2g. 108.04 (3) (b) of the statutes is renumbered 108.04 (3) (b) 1. a. and
19	amended to read:
20	108.04 (3) (b) 1. a. Paragraph (a) does not apply with respect to benefit years
21	that begin after March 12, 2020, and before February 7 March 14, 2021.
22	2. The department shall seek the maximum amount of federal reimbursement
23	for benefits that are, during the <u>any</u> time period specified in this paragraph <u>subd. 1.</u> ,

payable for the first week of a claimant's benefit year as a result of the application
 of this paragraph <u>subd. 1</u>.

SECTION 2r. 108.04 (3) (b) 1. b. of the statutes is created to read:

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108.04 (3) (b) 1. b. In addition to the period specified in subd. 1. a., the secretary
may suspend the application of par. (a) for any period during which federal
reimbursement is available to pay benefits for the first week of a claimant's benefit
year.".

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4. Page 6, line 16: after that line insert:

9 "(dg) The department shall allocate all available federal funding for the project
10 under par. (a) before allocating any general purpose revenue for that purpose.

11 (dr) If federal funding is received for the project under par. (a) prior to July 1, 122023, the secretary of administration may, to the extent permitted under federal law, 13lapse from the appropriation under s. 20.445 (1) (nc) to the general fund an amount 14 not to exceed the amounts in the schedule under s. 20.445 (1) (ar) or the amount of federal funding received, whichever is less. This paragraph does not apply with 15respect to amounts received as administrative grants by the state under 42 USC 502 16 or to amounts received by this state under section 903 (d) of the federal Social 1718 Security Act, as amended, 42 USC 1103.".
