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## ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 120

March 9, 2021 - Offered by Committee on Regulatory Licensing Reform.

At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

- 1. Page 8, line 18: delete lines 18 to 22 and substitute:
- "(7) APPLICABILITY. (a) If the federal government establishes a licensing program for 3rd-party logistics providers, the board shall evaluate the federal licensing program to determine whether licensing by this state of resident 3rd-party logistics provider is required for a resident 3rd-party logistics provider to provide 3rd-party logistics provider services in another state. If the board determines under this subsection that licensing by this state is not required, this section does not apply.
- (b) By 2 years after the effective date of this paragraph .... [LRB inserts date], and biennially thereafter, the board shall evaluate whether continued licensing by this state of resident 3rd-party logistics providers is required for a resident 3rd-party logistics provider to provide 3rd-party logistics provider services in another state and, if the board determines licensing in this state is required, submit

- to the legislative reference bureau for publication in the Wisconsin Administrative
- 2 Register a notice continuing the licensing under this section. This section does not
- 3 apply unless the board submits the notice under this paragraph.".
