**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 128**

October 14, 2021 – Offered by Representative CABRAL-GUEVARA.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 1: delete “informed” and substitute “written”.

3 **2.** Page 2, line 1: delete “50.373 (1)” and substitute “**50.373 Pelvic**
4 **examinations on anesthetized or unconscious female patients. (1)**”.

5 **3.** Page 2, line 3: delete the material beginning with “written and” and ending
6 with “informed” on line 4 and substitute “written”.

7 **4.** Page 2, line 7: delete “unconscious” and substitute “unconscious, except as
8 provided in sub. (3)”.

9 **5.** Page 2, line 7: after that line insert:

10 “(3) A policy under sub. (2) may not prohibit any person authorized to perform
11 a pelvic examination from performing a pelvic examination on a patient when the
12 patient is unconscious, a pelvic examination is required for diagnostic purposes, and

1 it would be detrimental to the patient to delay examination until written consent can
2 be obtained.”.

3 **6.** Page 2, line 8: delete “**(3)**” and substitute “**(4)**”.
