ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 170

April 16, 2021 – Offered by Representative TITTL.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	1. Page 2, line 1: delete lines 1 to 12.
3	${f 2.}$ Page 3, line 6: delete lines 6 and 7 and substitute "with the first initial and
4	last name of the individual.".
5	${f 3.}$ Page 3, line 9: delete "question." and substitute "question, except that this
6	subdivision does not apply to a name tag or badge worn by an individual observing
7	a recount under s. 9.01 that includes a candidate's campaign logo or the name of the
8	organization that the observer represents.".
9	4. Page 3, line 16: delete lines 16 to 18 and substitute:
10	"SECTION 3d. 9.01 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:
11	9.01 (3) REPRESENTATION AND OBSERVATION. The petitioner, all opposing
12	candidates and interested persons shall be entitled to be present in person and by
13	counsel to observe the proceedings. <u>The board of canvassers shall establish</u>

1	observation areas that are no more than 3 feet from a table where ballots and other
2	election-related materials are being examined and processed.
3	SECTION 3f. 12.13 (2) (b) 9. of the statutes is created to read:
4	12.13 (2) (b) 9. Intentionally obstructs an election observer's access to observe
5	election procedures.
6	SECTION 3g. 12.60 (1) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:
7	12.60 (1) (b) Whoever violates s. 12.03, 12.05, 12.07, 12.08 or 12.13 (2) (b) 8. $\underline{\text{or}}$
8	9., (3) (b), (c), (d), (g), (i), (n) to (x), (ze), (zm) or (zn) may be fined not more than \$1,000,
9	or imprisoned not more than 6 months or both.".
