## ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 258

May 13, 2021 – Offered by Representatives STEINEKE and STUBBS.

1 AN ACT to create 165.989 of the statutes; relating to: community-oriented

2 policing-house grant program.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Justice to distribute grants to cities with a population of 30,000 or more to fund community-oriented policing-house programs. The bill specifies certain criteria that DOJ must consider in awarding the grants.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- 3 **SECTION 1.** 165.989 of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 165.989 Community-oriented policing-house grant program. The
- 5 department of justice shall award grants to cities with a population of 30,000 or more
- 6 to fund community-oriented policing-house programs. The department of justice
- 7 shall use the following criteria in awarding grants under this section:

(1) The ability to maximize grant resources to serve the greatest number of
 people and the greatest number of cities.

3 (2) The city's plan to integrate the community-oriented policing house into the
4 fabric of the community and the neighborhood.

5 (3) The future ability to use the community-oriented policing house for 6 multiple purposes, including building relationships between law enforcement and 7 the community and connecting residents of the neighborhood to community 8 supports.

9 (4) The ability for community organizations, government agencies, 10 faith-based organizations, and other nonprofit entities to use the 11 community-oriented policing house once it is established.
