ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1, TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 2, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 520

At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

- 1. Page 2, line 3: after "permanently" insert ", or, if the court finds in its discretion that there are compelling reasons for an order that is less than permanent, for a period that is less than permanent but longer than otherwise permitted under this subsection,".
- **2.** Page 2, line 5: after "crime victim." insert "If the court orders an injunction that is less than permanent under this subdivision, the court shall state, in writing, its reasons for that decision.".
- **3.** Page 2, line 9: after "permanently" insert ", or, if the court finds it in its discretion that there are compelling reasons for an order that is less than permanent, for a period that is less than permanent but longer than otherwise permitted under this subsection,".

- **7.** Page 2, line 21: after "permanently" insert ", or, if the court finds it in its discretion that there are compelling reasons for an order that is less than permanent, for a period that is less than permanent but longer than otherwise permitted under this subsection,".
- **8.** Page 3, line 2: after "crime victim." insert "If the court orders an injunction that is less than permanent under this subdivision, the court shall state, in writing, its reasons for that decision.".
