ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 5, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 563

September 28, 2021 - Offered by Representatives Vos and Thiesfeldt.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	1. Page 1, line 4: after "requirements;" insert "private school educational
3	program criteria;".
4	${f 2.}$ Page 3, line 23: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with
5	page 4, line 3, and substitute:
6	"SECTION 2. 118.165 (1) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:
7	118.165 (1) (d) The program provides a sequentially progressive curriculum of
8	fundamental instruction in reading, language arts, mathematics, social studies,
9	science, and health. This subsection does not require the program to include in its
10	curriculum any concept, topic, or practice in conflict with the program's religious
11	doctrines <u>or mission</u> or to exclude from its curriculum any concept, topic, or practice
12	consistent with the program's religious doctrines <u>or mission</u> .".
13	3. Page 4, line 12: after that line insert:

15	an application to attend a private school under a parental choice program in the
16	2022-23 school year.".
