**SENATE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 932**

March 8, 2022 - Offered by Senators PFAFF, LARSON, CARPENTER, JOHNSON, AGARD,  
SMITH, RINGHAND and ERPENBACH.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 2: after “programs” insert “; funding for apprenticeship and  
3 youth apprenticeship programs, special education, and the University of Wisconsin  
4 System; and making an appropriation”.

5 **2.** Page 2, line 1: delete lines 1 to 22.

6 **3.** Page 3, line 1: delete “(b)” and substitute “(1) APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMS.”.

7 **4.** Page 3, line 2: delete “paragraph” and substitute “subsection”.

8 **5.** Page 3, line 3: delete “allocated under par. (a)” and substitute “appropriated  
9 under SECTION 2 (1) of this act.”.

10 **6.** Page 3, line 3: after that line insert:

11 **“SECTION 2. Fiscal changes.**

1           (1) APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMS. In the schedule under s. 20.005 (3) for the  
2           appropriation to the department of workforce development under s. 20.445 (1) (dr),  
3           the dollar amount in each of fiscal years 2021-22 and 2022-23 is increased by  
4           \$10,000,000 to do all of the following:

5           (a) Promote and expand the availability of apprenticeship programs approved  
6           under subch. I of ch. 106, focusing on the following objectives:

7           1. Increasing participation in existing approved programs.

8           2. Increasing the number of approved programs.

9           3. Expanding the trades, crafts, and businesses in which approved programs  
10          are available.

11          (b) Promote and provide information on the youth apprenticeship program  
12          under s. 106.13. The department shall focus its efforts under this subdivision on  
13          school districts that do not participate in the youth apprenticeship program and that  
14          have lower participation rates in the program.

15          (c) Provide additional funding for apprenticeship completion awards under s.  
16          106.05 (2).

17          (d) Bridge connections between the youth apprenticeship program under s.  
18          106.13 and apprenticeship programs described in par. (a).

19          (2) SPECIAL EDUCATION AID. In the schedule under s. 20.005 (3) for the  
20          appropriation to the department of public instruction under s. 20.255 (2) (b), the  
21          dollar amount for fiscal year 2022-23 is increased by \$6,320,000 to increase funding  
22          for aids for special education under s. 115.88.

23          (3) UW SYSTEM; GENERAL PROGRAM OPERATIONS. In the schedule under s. 20.005  
24          (3) for the appropriation to the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin

1 System under s. 20.285 (1) (a), the dollar amount for fiscal year 2022-23 is increased  
2 by \$1,580,000 for the purpose for which the appropriation is made.”.
