ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO SENATE BILL 119

June 22, 2021 - Offered by Representatives McGuire, Spreitzer, Andraca, Emerson, Conley, Vining, Ohnstad and Bowen.

1	AN ACT to renumber and amend 79.01 (2d) and 79.035 (5); to repeal and
2	$\pmb{recreate}\ 79.035\ (5)\ (a)\ and\ 79.035\ (5)\ (b);\ and\ \pmb{to}\ \pmb{create}\ 79.01\ (2d)\ (c),\ 79.01\ (2d)$
3	(d) and 79.035 (5) (b) of the statutes; relating to: increasing county and
4	municipal aid payments.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill increases the amount that each county and municipality annually receives as a county and municipal aid payment. Currently, a county or municipality receives a payment equal to what it received in 2012. The bill increases that amount by 2 percent in 2021 and additional 2 percent beginning in 2022.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

5 SECTION 1. 79.01 (2d) of the statutes is renumbered 79.01 (2d) (intro.) and 6 amended to read:

79.01 (2d) (intro.) There is established an account in the general fund entitled
the "County and Municipal Aid Account." The total amount to be distributed in 2011
to counties and municipalities from the county and municipal aid account is as
<u>follows:</u>
(a) In 2011, \$824,825,715 and the total amount to be distributed to counties and
municipalities in.
(b) Beginning in 2012, and in each year thereafter, from the county and
municipal aid account is and ending in 2020, \$748,075,715.
Section 2. 79.01 (2d) (c) of the statutes is created to read:
79.01 (2d) (c) In 2021, \$763,137,230.
Section 3. 79.01 (2d) (d) of the statutes is created to read:
79.01 (2d) (d) In 2022, and in each year thereafter, \$778,499,974.
Section 4. 79.035 (5) of the statutes is renumbered 79.035 (5) (a) and amended
to read:
79.035 (5) (a) Except as provided in subs. (6), (7), and (8), for the distribution
distributions beginning in 2013 and subsequent years ending in 2020, each county
and municipality shall receive a payment under this section that is equal to the
amount of the payment determined for the county or municipality under this section
for 2012.
Section 5. 79.035 (5) (a) of the statutes, as affected by 2019 Wisconsin Act 19,
section 18, and 2021 Wisconsin Act (this act), is repealed and recreated to read:
79.035 (5) (a) Except as provided in subs. (7) and (8), for the distributions
beginning in 2013 and ending in 2020, each county and municipality shall receive
a payment under this section that is equal to the amount of the payment determined
for the county or municipality under this section for 2012.

13	2021, each county and municipality shall receive a payment under this section that
14	is equal to the amount of the payment determined for the county or municipality
15	under this section for 2020, increased by 2 percent.
16	2. Except as provided in subs. (7) and (8), for the distribution in 2022 and
17	subsequent years, each county and municipality shall receive a payment under this
18	section that is equal to the amount of the payment determined for the county or
19	municipality under this section for 2021, increased by 2 percent.
20	Section 8. Effective dates. This act takes effect on the day after publication,
