ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 259

June 9, 2025 - Offered by Representative DALLMAN.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows: $\mathbf{2}$ **1.** Page 2, line 8: delete the material beginning with that line and ending 3 with page 3, line 7, and substitute: 4 "SECTION 2g. 943.13 (1m) (g) of the statutes is created to read: $\mathbf{5}$ 943.13 (1m) (g) Enters or remains on the premises of a campground after 6 having been notified not to enter or remain on the premises or after having been 7 notified that the owner or operator has withdrawn consent for the person to enter or 8 remain on the premises. A law enforcement officer may, at the request of the owner 9 or operator, assist the owner or operator in removing from the premises a person In this paragraph, "campground" means a 10 who violates this paragraph. 11 campground or camping resort licensed under s. 97.67 but does not include a 12campground under s. 27.01 (10).

1 SECTION 2h. 943.13 (2) (am) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

943.13 (2) (am) (intro.) A person has received notice from the owner, operator,
or occupant within the meaning of sub. (1m) (b), (e) or, (f), or (g) if he or she has been
notified personally, either orally or in writing, or if the land is posted. Land is
considered to be posted under this paragraph under either of the following
procedures:".
