## SENATE AMENDMENT 1, TO SENATE BILL 242

June 9, 2025 - Offered by Senator KAPENGA.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	<b>1.</b> Page 1, line 3: before that line insert:
3	"SECTION 1a. 106.015 (1g) of the statutes is created to read:
4	106.015 (1g) In this section, "construction trade" means a trade, craft, or
5	business that the department has, for purposes of its approval of apprenticeship
6	programs under this chapter, identified as being a construction trade.".
7	<b>2.</b> Page 1, line 3: delete that line and substitute " <b>SECTION 1b.</b> 106.015 (1) of
8	the statutes is renumbered 106.015 (1m) and amended to read:".
9	<b>3.</b> Page 1, line 4: delete "(1)" and substitute "(1m)".
10	<b>4.</b> Page 1, line 4: delete "sub." and substitute " <del>sub.</del> subs. (1s) and".

1	5. Page 2, line 2: delete that line and substitute "each apprentice in any
2	trade, craft, or business that is not a construction trade.".
3	<b>6.</b> Page 2, line 2: after that line insert:
4	"SECTION 1g. 106.015 (1s) of the statutes is created to read:
5	106.015 (1s) Except as provided in subs. (1m) and (2), the department may
6	not prescribe, enforce, or authorize, whether through the promulgation of a rule,
7	the issuance of a general or special order, the approval of an apprenticeship
8	program or apprentice contract, or otherwise, a ratio of apprentices to
9	journeyworkers for apprenticeship programs or apprentice contracts that requires
10	more than one journeyworker for 2 apprentices in a construction trade.
11	<b>SECTION 1r.</b> 106.015 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:
12	106.015 (2) The <del>prohibition</del> <u>prohibitions</u> under <del>sub.</del> <u>subs.</u> (1) <del>does</del> <u>and (1s) do</u>
13	not apply with respect to apprentices whose employment is governed by a collective
14	bargaining agreement.".
15	<b>7.</b> Page 2, line 3: delete lines 3 to 7.
