#### GENERAL EDUCATION AND CULTURAL AGENCIES

#### Funding for the emergency weather warning system

Under current law, the Educational Communications Board is required to operate an emergency weather warning system, the operation of which is funded from moneys received from DOA for the provision of state telecommunications to state agencies. This bill changes the funding source for the operation of the emergency weather warning system to GPR.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**SECTION 1.** 20.225 (1) (kb) of the statutes is renumbered 20.225 (1) (d) and amended to read:

20.225 (1) (d) Emergency weather warning system operation. From the moneys received by the department of administration for the provision of state telecommunications to state agencies, the The amounts in the schedule for the operation of the emergency weather warning system under s. 39.11 (21).

**SECTION 2.** 20.505 (1) (kL) of the statutes is amended to read:

20.505 (1) (kL) Printing, mail, communication, document sales, and

information technology services; state agencies; veterans services. The amounts in the schedule to provide document sales, printing, mail processing, electronic communications, information technology development, management, and processing services, but not enterprise resource planning system services under s. 16.971 (2) (cf), to state agencies and veterans services under s. 16.973 (9). All moneys received for the provision of document sales services and services under ss. 16.971, 16.972, 16.973, 16.974 (3), and 16.997 (2) (d), other than moneys received and disbursed under par. (ip) and s. 20.225 (1) (kb), shall be credited to this appropriation account.
