ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD AMENDING RULES

The Wisconsin Natural Resources Board adopts an order to amend NR 25.06(2)(c)1., relating to commercial fishing in Lake Michigan

The order reduces the total annual allowable commercial harvest of smelt that may be taken from Green Bay from 351,993 pounds to 25,000 pounds.

SECTION 1. NR 25.06(2)(c)1. is amended to read:

NR 25.06(2)(c)1. The total allowable commercial harvest of smelt in any license year may not exceed 1,000,000 pounds in Lake Michigan and Green Bay, of which no more than 351,993 25,000 pounds may be taken from Green Bay.

SECTION 2. REVIEW. The Department of Natural Resources will conduct a review and evaluation of the annual harvest limit established by this order one year following the effective date of this rule. The results of this review and evaluation will be presented to the Natural Resources Board.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. The rule contained in SECTION 1 shall take effect on July 1, 2004.

SECTION 4. BOARD ADOPTION. This rule was approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on February 25, 2004.
