## 2021 Wisconsin Act 257 [2021 Senate Bill 535]

## Liability Exemption for Eyeglasses Provided by Charities

2021 Wisconsin Act 257 creates an exemption from liability for a charitable organization<sup>1</sup> that provides previously owned eyeglasses. Specifically, a charitable organization is not liable for any damages arising out of providing previously owned eyeglasses to an individual if all of the following apply:

- The recipient of the eyeglasses is at least 14 years of age.
- The eyeglasses are provided without charge.
- For distribution of the eyeglasses, the eyeglasses are provided by a licensed optometrist or ophthalmologist who has done any of the following:
  - Personally examined the individual who will receive the eyeglasses and issued a prescription for the eyeglasses.
  - Personally consulted with the licensed optometrist or ophthalmologist who issued the prescription for the eyeglasses.
