2021 Wisconsin Act 45 [2021 Senate Bill 171]

Licensing Inspections for Camps

2021 Wisconsin Act 45 allows the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP), or a local health department, to waive a routine inspection for licensing renewal of a recreational or educational camp if the camp has exhibited effective managerial control of public health hazards. The routine inspection may be waived for up to two years in a three-year period.

The standard for effective managerial control is to be defined by DATCP by administrative rule.
