Utility-Terrain Vehicle Weight Limits

2021 WISCONSIN ACT 70

In Wisconsin, the operation of all-terrain vehicles and utility-terrain vehicles (UTVs) is primarily regulated under state law. The statutes define UTV using a variety of vehicle attributes, including a vehicle's weight. For a vehicle to be considered a UTV, prior law required that the vehicle be originally manufactured with a weight of 2,000 pounds or less, without fluids. 2021 Wisconsin Act 70 raised this weight limit to 3,000 pounds, without fluids.
