2021 Wisconsin Act 71 [2021 Senate Bill 329] Repeal of Consulting Physician Requirement for Athletic Trainers

2021 WISCONSIN ACT 71

Prior law provided that an athletic trainer must have a consulting physician approve of the athletic trainer's evaluation and treatment protocol and that an athletic trainer's consulting physician may require the athletic trainer to refer a patient to another provider if the consulting physician determines that the patient has a medical condition that is beyond the scope of practice of the athletic trainer.

Act 71 repeals the requirement that an athletic trainer have a consulting physician.

Effective date: July 10, 2021
