

2019 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 142

February 17, 2020 – Introduced by Representatives KERKMAN, MCGUIRE and OHNSTAD, cosponsored by Senators WANGGAARD and WIRCH. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1	Relating to: honoring the life and commemorating the contributions of Kenosha
2	resident Ralph Tenuta.
3	Whereas, Ralph Tenuta was born on May 26, 1932, in Kenosha, Wisconsin, and
4	passed away on January 15, 2020, in Kenosha County; and
5	Whereas, Tenuta worked with his father to open the iconic Tenuta's
6	Delicatessen and Grocery Store in Kenosha on September 1, 1950, which continues
7	to operate to this day; and
8	Whereas, Tenuta employed and mentored hundreds of young employees from
9	the Kenosha area at his business, many of whom were serving in their first jobs; and
10	Whereas, he was a pillar of Kenosha and, as such, was deeply involved in his
11	community to ensure that it continues to be a great place to live; and
12	Whereas, he was a charter member of the Kenosha Boys and Girls Club,
13	Kenosha Rotary West, and the 52nd Street Businessmen's Association; and
14	Whereas, he helped establish the American State Bank, served as its board
15	chairman, and also sat on the Wisconsin Banking Review Board for two decades; and

2	Parkside, served as the president of its Benevolent Foundation, and received the
3	University of Wisconsin – Parkside Lifetime Recognition Award; and

5	Flame Award in 2006; and
6	Whereas, he was beloved by his late wife, Margaret, their seven children, and
7	their many grandchildren; now, therefore, be it
8	Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the members of the
9	Wisconsin State Legislature honor the life and commemorate the contributions of
10	Ralph Tenuta; and, be it further
11	<i>Resolved, That</i> the assembly chief clerk shall provide a copy of this resolution
