2019 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 7

September 17, 2019 - Introduced by Representative PETRYK. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1 **Relating to:** proclaiming September 2019 as Workforce Development Month.

2 Whereas, Wisconsin employers have posted over 90,000 jobs on the state's labor
3 market exchange, and are struggling to find employees to fill those positions; and

4 Whereas, Wisconsin employers understand that having access to a qualified
5 and skilled workforce will help to grow Wisconsin's economy; and

6 Whereas, Wisconsin initiatives like Wisconsin Fast Forward, Career and
7 Technical Education Incentive Grants, and Youth and Registered Apprenticeship
8 Programs, in tandem with programming under the Federal Workforce Innovation
9 and Opportunity Act, help individuals enter the employment market and give them
10 the skills necessary to maximize their readiness for work; and

11 Whereas, continuing to strengthen the connections between Wisconsin's
12 educational systems and workforce programs on the local, state, and federal levels
13 are essential to ensuring future workforce development; and
