Under this bill, the special observance day Columbus Day is renamed Indigenous Peoples Day.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3     **SECTION 1.** 118.02 (12) of the statutes is amended to read:  
4     118.02 (12) The 2nd Monday in October 12, Christopher Columbus' birthday  
5     , Indigenous Peoples Day.  
6     **SECTION 2.** 421.301 (6) of the statutes is amended to read:  
7     421.301 (6) "Business day" means any calendar day except Saturday and  
8     Sunday, and except the following business holidays: New Year's Day, Martin Luther  
9     King Jr.'s Birthday, Washington's Birthday, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor
