3 Whereas, on July 7, 2019, the United States Women's National Team (USWNT)
4 won the FIFA Women's World Cup in Lyon, France, with a final of score of 2-0 against
5 the Netherlands; and

6 Whereas, University of Wisconsin Badgers alum and midfielder, Rose Lavelle,
7 scored the game-clinching final goal, after forward Megan Rapinoe scored the first
8 with a penalty shot, both in the second half; and

9 Whereas, coach Jill Ellis led the USWNT to its second consecutive and record
10 fourth overall FIFA Women's World Cup title; and

11 Whereas, every 2019 USWNT Women's World Cup match in Lyon was sold out
12 before the tournament began; and

13 Whereas, the USWNT has a level of support unrivaled in women's sports, with
14 a following of tens of thousands of fans all over the world; and
