2021 ASSEMBLY BILL 1194

March 10, 2022 – Introduced by Representative BOWEN. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1 AN ACT *to create* 947.09 of the statutes; **relating to:** providing material support 2 to an organization that is engaged in domestic terrorism and providing a 3 penalty.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under this bill, it is a Class G felony to provide material support or resources to an organization that is engaged in domestic terrorism. Under the bill, domestic terrorism means engaging in activities that are dangerous to human life and that are a violation of the criminal laws of the United States or of any state; that appear to be intended to intimidate or coerce a civilian population, influence the policy of a government by intimidation or coercion, or affect the conduct of a government by mass destruction, assassination, or kidnapping; that serve an ideological goal; and that occur primarily within the United States. Under the bill, material support or resources means any tangible or intangible property or service except medicine or religious materials.

Because this bill creates a new crime or revises a penalty for an existing crime, the Joint Review Committee on Criminal Penalties may be requested to prepare a report.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4	(a) "Domestic terrorism" means activities to which all of the following apply:
5	1. The activities involve acts dangerous to human life that are a violation of the
6	criminal laws of the United States or of any state.
7	2. The activities appear to be intended to do one of the following:
8	a. Intimidate or coerce a civilian population.
9	b. Influence the policy of a government by intimidation or coercion.
10	c. Affect the conduct of a government by mass destruction, assassination, or
11	kidnapping.
12	3. The activities serve an ideological goal.
13	4. The activities occur primarily within the territorial jurisdiction of the United
14	States.
15	(b) "Expert advice or assistance" means advice or assistance derived from
16	scientific, technical, or other specialized knowledge.
17	(c) "Material support or resources" means any tangible or intangible property
18	or service, including currency or monetary instruments or financial securities,
19	financial services, lodging, training, expert advice or assistance, safehouses, false
20	documentation or identification, communications equipment, facilities, weapons,
21	lethal substances, explosives, personnel, and transportation, except medicine or
22	religious materials.
23	(d) "Training" means instruction or teaching designed to impart a specific skill,

1 (2) CRIMINAL PENALTY. Whoever knowingly provides material support or 2 resources to an organization that is engaged in domestic terrorism, or attempts or 3 conspires to do so, is guilty of a Class G felony.
