## **2021 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 7**

February 15, 2021 – Introduced by Representatives Plumer, Tranel, Novak, Allen, Kitchens, Magnafici, Armstrong, Skowronski, Tittl, Kerkman, Moses, Tusler, Murphy, Tauchen, Dallman, Spiros, Summerfield, Krug, Edming and Baldeh, cosponsored by Senators Marklein and Ballweg. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1	Relating to: reaffirming Wisconsin's commitment to the strengthening and
2	deepening of the sister ties between the State of Wisconsin and Taiwan;
3	supporting Taiwan's signing of a Bilateral Trade Agreement (BTA) with the
4	United States; and continued support for increasing Taiwan's international
5	profile.
6	Whereas, the State of Wisconsin established in 1986 the sister-state
7	relationship with the Taiwan Province, Republic of China (Taiwan), and Wisconsin
8	and Taiwan have enjoyed strong bilateral trade, educational and cultural exchange,
9	and tourism; and
10	Whereas, Taiwan shares the same values of freedom, democracy, human rights,
11	the rule of law, peace, and prosperity with the United States and the State of
12	Wisconsin; and
13	Whereas, the United States ranks as Taiwan's second-largest trading partner,
14	Taiwan ranks as the tenth-largest trading partner of the United States, and
15	bilateral trade reached \$85.5 billion in 2019; and

1	Whereas, Taiwan and the State of Wisconsin have enjoyed a long and mutually
2	beneficial relationship with the prospect of future growth, and Taiwan was
3	Wisconsin's seventh-largest export market in Asia in 2019, with nearly \$225 million
4	worth of Wisconsin goods exported to Taiwan; and
5	Whereas, negotiations for a Bilateral Trade Agreement (BTA) between Taiwan
6	and the United States are an important step toward further strengthening bilateral
7	trade between our countries, thereby increasing Wisconsin's exports to Taiwan and
8	creating bilateral investment and technical collaboration through tariff reduction
9	and other trade facilitation measures; and
10	Whereas, Taiwan has undertaken a policy of "steadfast diplomacy" in its
11	international relations, and Taiwan is capable of fulfilling and willing to fulfill its
12	responsibilities and collaborating with the world to deal with the challenges of
13	humanitarian aid, disease control, and so forth; now, therefore, be it
14	Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the Wisconsin
15	Legislature reaffirms its commitment to the strengthening and deepening of the
16	sister ties between the State of Wisconsin and Taiwan; and, be it further
17	<b>Resolved, That</b> Wisconsin endorses Taiwan's efforts to secure the signing of
18	a Bilateral Trade Agreement (BTA) with the United States and reiterates its support
19	for a closer economic and trade partnership between the State of Wisconsin and
20	Taiwan; and, be it further
21	Resolved, That Wisconsin continues to support Taiwan's appropriate
22	participation in international argonizations that impact the health sofety and

23	well-being of the people of Taiwan and supports Taiwan's aspiration to make more
