- March 10, 2022 Introduced by Senators BERNIER, BALLWEG, JACQUE and FELZKOWSKI, cosponsored by Representatives SCHRAA, THIESFELDT, BRANDTJEN, DITTRICH, DUCHOW, EDMING, HORLACHER, GUNDRUM, JAMES, KRUG, KUGLITSCH, MAGNAFICI, MURPHY, PRONSCHINSKE, ROZAR and STEFFEN. Referred to Committee on Government Operations, Legal Review and Consumer Protection.
- 1 AN ACT *to create* 16.84 (4) of the statutes; **relating to:** use of cafeteria in capitol
- 2 by students touring the capitol.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Administration to allow school groups that are touring the state capitol to use the cafeteria that is located in the basement of the capitol.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 16.84 (4) of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 16.84 (4) Allow school groups that are touring the state capitol building to use
- 5 the cafeteria facility located in the basement of the capitol.
