## 2021 SENATE BILL 244

March 24, 2021 - Introduced by Senators Testin, Nass, Wanggaard, Marklein, Bernier, Stroebel and Felzkowski, cosponsored by Representatives Kurtz, Krug, Jagler, Spiros, Callahan, Dittrich, Rozar, Armstrong, Edming, Tranel, Magnafici, James, Cabral-Guevara, Born, Brandtjen, Gundrum, Kuglitsch, Ramthun, Tauchen, Wichgers and Skowronski. Referred to Committee on Government Operations, Legal Review and Consumer Protection.

AN ACT to create 1.15 of the statutes; relating to: playing or singing the national anthem at certain sporting events.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under this bill, no sporting event may be held in a venue constructed at least in part with public moneys unless the event is preceded by the playing or singing of the national anthem.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 1.15 of the statutes is created to read:
1.15 Playing or singing the national anthem at certain sporting events.
(1) In this section:
(a) "Local governmental unit" means a political subdivision of this state, a school district or special purpose district in this state, an agency or corporation of a political subdivision, school district, or special purpose district, or a combination or subunit of any of the foregoing.
(b) "Political subdivision" means a city, village, town, or county.
(c) "State agency" means an association, authority, board, department, commission, independent agency, institution, office, society, or other body in state government created or authorized to be created by the constitution or any law.
(2) No sporting event may be held in a venue the construction of which was financed at least in part from moneys contributed by a state agency or local governmental unit unless the event is preceded by the playing or singing of the national anthem.
