### **2021 SENATE BILL 368**

May 25, 2021 - Introduced by Senators Stafsholt, Felzkowski, Bernier, Feyen, Marklein, Ringhand, Stroebel and L. Taylor, cosponsored by Representatives Swearingen, Edming, Armstrong, Brooks, Callahan, Mursau, Sortwell, Summerfield, Thiesfeldt, Tusler and VanderMeer. Referred to Committee on Transportation and Local Government.

- AN ACT to amend 23.33 (3) (em) and 23.33 (6r) of the statutes; relating to:
- 2 passenger restrictions on all-terrain vehicles.

#### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, no person may ride on an all-terrain vehicle (ATV) or utility terrain vehicle (UTV) on a part of the ATV or UTV that is not designed for use by passengers. A person is also prohibited from operating an ATV or UTV with such a passenger. This bill eliminates these restrictions as they apply to ATVs.

# The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- 3 **Section 1.** 23.33 (3) (em) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 4 23.33 (3) (em) Except as provided in sub. (11m), with a passenger riding in or
- 5 on any part of an all-terrain vehicle or <u>a</u> utility terrain vehicle that is not designed
- 6 or intended to be used by passengers.
