2021 SENATE BILL 455

July 21, 2021 - Introduced by Senators Agard, Smith, L. Taylor, Carpenter, Larson, Roys and Wirch, cosponsored by Representatives Snodgrass, Considine, Anderson, Andraca, Baldeh, Behnke, Billings, Cabrera, Conley, Neubauer, Ohnstad, Pope, Shankland, Shelton, Sinicki, Stubbs and Vining. Referred to Committee on Labor and Regulatory Reform.

- 1 AN ACT to create 29.601 (4m) of the statutes; relating to: ban on the use of
- 2 certain insecticides by the Department of Natural Resources.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits, with limited exceptions, the Department of Natural Resources from using any insecticide from the neonicotinoid class within a one-mile radius of any pollinator habitat located on land maintained by DNR. Under the bill, this prohibition does not apply to uses of this insecticide that are 1) pursuant to existing cooperative farming agreements or contracts or 2) for forest insect control on forested lands, state forest nurseries, or seed orchards or in designated zones of infestation.

- 3 **Section 1.** 29.601 (4m) of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 29.601 (4m) Use of insecticides. (a) The department may not use any
- 5 insecticide from the neonicotinoid class within a one-mile radius of any pollinator
