1	Relating to: proclaiming November 2021 to be Pancreatic Cancer Awareness

3	Whereas, this year, an estimated 60,430 adults in the United States will be
4	diagnosed with pancreatic cancer; and
5	Whereas, it is estimated that 48,220 deaths from this disease will occur this
6	year; and
7	Whereas, pancreatic cancer is the eighth most common cancer in women and
8	the tenth most common cancer in men; and
9	Whereas, this year, it is estimated that there will be 890 deaths from pancreatic
10	cancer in Wisconsin; and
11	Whereas, pancreatic cancer is the third-leading cause of cancer deaths in the
12	United States and Wisconsin; and
13	Whereas, the good health and well-being of the residents of Wisconsin are
14	enhanced as a direct result of increased awareness about pancreatic cancer and
15	research in early detection, causes, and effective treatments; now, therefore, be it
