Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, technical college district boards must be composed of nine members who are residents of the district. This bill requires that technical college district board members also be United States citizens.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 38.08 (1) (a) 1. (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:
