1	Relating to: condemning Hamas' barbaric attack against Israel.
2	Whereas, on October 7, 2023, Hamas, a United States-designated Foreign
3	Terrorist Organization, attacked Israel without provocation, murdering innocent
4	civilians in a ground assault and launching more than 4,500 rockets
5	indiscriminately; and
6	Whereas, this heinous attack by Hamas terrorists resulted in the murder of
7	hundreds of innocent civilians of all ages; and
8	Whereas, the evil actions of these terrorists resulted in the death of at least 14
9	innocent Americans, as well as many other foreign nationals; and
10	Whereas, Hamas terrorists have taken civilians hostage, resulting in the
11	abhorrent and inhumane treatment of innocent people, including many children and
12	elderly people; and

1	Whereas, this massive act of terrorism took place during Shabbat and the
2	Jewish holidays of Shemini Atzeret/Simchat Torah and one day after the 50th
3	anniversary of the start of the 1973 Yom Kippur War against Israel; and
4	Whereas, the Israeli people have suffered a violent attack, clearly designed to
5	maximize terror and harm to civilians, resulting in the largest mass slaughter of
6	Jews since the Holocaust; and
7	Whereas, this attack is yet another instance of the centuries-long persecution
8	and anti-Semitism that Jewish people have suffered; now, therefore, be it
9	Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the Wisconsin
10	State Legislature condemns the actions of Hamas' barbaric attack against Israel;
11	and, be it further
12	Resolved, That the Wisconsin State Legislature calls on Hamas to
13	immediately cease violent hostilities and return all hostages unharmed; and, be it
14	further
15	Resolved, That Wisconsin expresses its condolences and support to all affected
16	families; and, be it further
17	Resolved, That Wisconsin stands in solidarity with the Israeli people and
18	reaffirms its unwavering commitment to Israel's sovereignty and security.
