2023 SENATE BILL 780

December 8, 2023 - Introduced by Senators Quinn, Ballweg and Marklein, cosponsored by Representatives Pronschinske, Allen, Armstrong, Behnke, Bodden, Brandtjen, C. Anderson, Callahan, Edming, Goeben, Magnafici, Moses, Mursau and Penterman. Referred to Committee on Financial Institutions and Sporting Heritage.

- 1 AN ACT *to amend* 29.563 (2) (b) 6. and 29.563 (2) (b) 6m. of the statutes; **relating**
- **to:** nonresident archer and crossbow hunting license fees.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Department of Natural Resources issues approvals that authorize the hunting of specified wild animals. Current law provides the fee for each approval and, for certain approvals, a separate processing or issuing fee. This bill increases the fee for the nonresident archer hunting license and the nonresident crossbow hunting license from \$162.25 to \$197.25, which is the current fee for a nonresident deer hunting license.
