1	Relating to: proclaiming November 2023 to be Pancreatic Cancer Awareness
2	Month.
3	Whereas, this year, an estimated 64,050 adults in the United States will be
4	diagnosed with pancreatic cancer; and
5	Whereas, it is estimated that 50,550 deaths from this disease will occur this
6	year; and
7	Whereas, pancreatic cancer is the seventh most common cancer in women and
8	the ninth most common cancer in men; and
9	Whereas, this year, it is estimated that there will be 1,020 deaths from
10	pancreatic cancer in Wisconsin; and
11	Whereas, in 2023, pancreatic cancer may be the third-leading cause of cancer
12	deaths in the United States and the second-leading cause of cancer deaths in
13	Wisconsin; and

1 Whereas, the good health and well-being of the residents of Wisconsin are 2 enhanced as a direct result of increased awareness about pancreatic cancer and 3 research in early detection, causes, and effective treatments; now, therefore, be it
