1 Relating to: congratulating the Milwaukee Rufus King Cheer and Stunt Team on 2 their double state championship win in 2025. 3 Whereas, on February 22, 2025, the Milwaukee Rufus King Cheer and Stunt 4 Team ended their 2025 season by competing in the Wisconsin Association of Cheer 5 and Pom Coaches (WACPC) championship competition; and 6 Whereas, the Milwaukee Rufus King Cheer and Stunt Team defeated all other 7 teams to become the first-place champions in the Non-Tumble division; and 8 Whereas, the Milwaukee Rufus King Cheer and Stunt Team defeated all other 9 teams to become the first-place champions in the Cheer Dance division; and 10 Whereas, this is the first time in the history of MPS athletics that two cheer championships were obtained in the same season; and 11 12 Whereas, the team was led by head coach Olivia Raasch, Ryonna Hendricks, 13 Kydra Johnson, and Destiny Tillman; and
