



2025 SENATE BILL 288

May 30, 2025 - Introduced by Senators BRADLEY, SPREITZER, DASSLER-ALFHEIM, FEYEN, KEYESKI, RATCLIFF, TESTIN and WIRCH, cosponsored by Representatives KAUFERT, TRANEL, CALLAHAN, CLANCY, DESMIDT, GOEBEN, GUNDRUM, JOHNSON, KNODL, KREIBICH, MADISON, MAXEY, O'CONNOR, PENTERMAN, SUBECK, WICHGERS and WITTKE. 1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 347.25 (3) of the statutes; **relating to:** authorized lights for
2 funeral procession vehicles.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the lead vehicle, or all vehicles, in a funeral procession may be equipped with a flashing amber light to be used during the procession. This bill authorizes the use of a flashing purple light during a funeral procession.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 347.25 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 347.25 **(3)** The lead vehicle in a funeral procession may be equipped, or any

5 vehicle in the procession may be equipped if all vehicles in the procession are so

6 equipped, with a flashing amber or purple light that may be used only in the

7 procession.
