



## 2025 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 12

March 7, 2025 - Introduced by Senators SPREITZER, DRAKE, HESSELBEIN, LARSON, PFAFF, RATCLIFF and ROYS, cosponsored by Representatives ROE, ANDRACA, ARNEY, BARE, BROWN, CLANCY, DESMIDT, EMERSON, FITZGERALD, J. JACOBSON, JOERS, KIRSCH, MIRESE, MOORE OMOKUNDE, ORTIZ-VELEZ, PALMERI, PHELPS, SINICKI, SUBECK, UDELL and TENORIO. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1     **Relating to:** designating the month of March as Endosalpingiosis Awareness  
2           Month.

3           Whereas, Endosalpingiosis is a rare disease that primarily affects women  
4     between the ages of 20 to 49 years; and

5           Whereas, Endosalpingiosis is characterized by the presence of tubal  
6     epithelium outside of the fallopian tube; and

7           Whereas, the prevalence of Endosalpingiosis is difficult to establish, since it is  
8     diagnosed only through surgical biopsy; and

9           Whereas, common symptoms of Endosalpingiosis include pelvic pain,  
10    infertility, menstrual irregularities, and dyspareunia, along with chronic back pain  
11    being reported as a common issue years before diagnosis; and

12          Whereas, some of the biggest issues that patients face are uncertainty about  
13    how the condition develops and a lack of doctors who specialize in Endosalpingiosis;
