On February 15, 2019, Sheila T. Reiff, Clerk of the Supreme Court and Court of Appeals, filed a rule petition asking the court to authorize a pilot project and to adopt an interim rule to facilitate the development and testing of procedures to effectuate electronic filing of documents in the Court of Appeals and Supreme Court.

The court discussed this petition at a closed rules conference on February 19, 2019, and voted to solicit comment and schedule a public hearing.

IT IS ORDERED that a public hearing on the petition shall be held in the Supreme Court Room in the State Capitol, Madison, Wisconsin, on Monday, April 8, 2019 at 9:30 a.m.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that notice of the hearing be given by a publication of a copy of this order and of the petition in the official state newspaper once each week for three consecutive weeks, and in an official publication of the State Bar of Wisconsin not more than 60 days nor less than 30 days before the date of the hearing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the full text of the proposed rules, including changes, if any, in existing rules, shall be placed on the
