## **RESOLUTION NO. 2005-03**

## A Resolution Supporting the Requirement to Show Voter Identification

WHEREAS, the Help America Vote Act of 2002 was enacted to improve the voting system and voter access; and

WHEREAS, under HAVA, a centralized, interactive computerized Statewide Voter Registration System is scheduled to be in place by January 1, 2006; and

WHEREAS, voter registration lists are prepared before Election Day to provide election inspectors with the names of all voters who are registered to vote at the polling place; and

WHEREAS, currently, an elector enters the polling place and states his/her name and address prior to receiving a ballot; and

WHEREAS, this procedure provides an opportunity for the election inspectors to determine if the elector is a qualified voter and provides the opportunity for other electors or election inspectors to challenge the elector's voting qualifications; and

WHEREAS, the announcement by the elector of his/her name and address is heard only by a few citizens in the polling place, limiting the possibility of a challenge; and

WHEREAS, election inspectors who provide the elector with a ballot have no course of action to verify whether the elector is the person on the voter registration list; and

WHEREAS, by requiring voter identification prior to receiving a ballot, it will be assured that the elector is qualified to vote under the name and address given.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council of the City of Cedarburg hereby petitions the State of Wisconsin Legislature to require registered electors to provide voter identification to election inspectors prior to receiving a ballot on Election Day.
